DECISION AND ORDER

Ayomikun Bus Charters Ltd. applied to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on July 23, 2026, for approval to amend its Extra-Provincial Operating License XP03565 by adding one (1) 7-passenger vehicle to operate under its existing rates and authorities.

Notice of the application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, August 5, 2026, and notice provided to the industry. There were no objections received by the stated deadline of August 12, 2026.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on August 25, 2026.

Having considered the Motor Carrier Act, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the application.

The Board approves the application and orders that the license be amended, effective immediately.
