

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**TIMOTHY PECK ET AL** have made an appeal to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board from a decision of the Town of Digby Council approving a Development Agreement allowing 4576251 Nova Scotia Limited to redevelop lands on Thomas Road for the purpose of constructing three (3) multiple unit residential structures containing a total of 76 dwelling units, together with the construction of related streets and infrastructure on Thomas Road, Digby, Nova Scotia (PIDs 30383731 and 30228522).
