M12273 – Board Inquiry into Nova Scotia Power Incorporated’s Cybersecurity Incident

On March 25, 2026, the Office of the Privacy Commissioner of Canada issued a news release advising that NS Power has committed to take steps to strengthen its security measures following the cyberattack that impacted more than 900,000 current and former customers and, through a compliance letter, agreed to implement measures to ensure stronger privacy protections for NS Power customers going forward. A digital version of the compliance letter was also posted on the Commissioner's website.


The Board reviewed the compliance letter. Information publicly disclosed in this letter was similar to some information that NS Power had previously redacted in its filings in this matter with the Nova Scotia Energy Board.

To ensure that as much information as possible is included on the public record in this proceeding, the Board therefore directs NS Power to review and refile the following documents previously filed in this matter, removing redactions consistent with the information that has now been publicly disclosed (either through the Office of the Privacy Commissioner of Canada process or otherwise since the information was originally filed with the Energy Board):

- Submissions filed with the Energy Board about NS Power’s claim for confidentiality on August 8, 2025;
- a confidential letter on behalf of NS Power included with its Monthly Update Report #1 on August 20, 2025;
- NS Power’s confidential responses to Board Information Requests (Exhibit N-2(C)); and
- NS Power’s Cybersecurity Incident Report dated December 22, 2025 (Exhibit N-3(C)).

NS Power is directed to file updated documents no later than **Monday, April 20, 2026**.
