

## **NOVA SCOTIA ENERGY BOARD**

## NOTICE OF PAPER HEARING

NSP Maritime Link Inc. (NSPML) has applied to the Board for approval of a capital project of an estimated \$33 million amount related to submarine cable protection for the Maritime Link. The application requests that, if approved by the Board, the amount be recovered commencing in NSPML's 2026 cost assessment. The application requests approval of the following:

- To progress with the Submarine Cable Protection Project and for it to be added to rate base based on final costing. NSPML states it will provide a final costing report once the project is complete;
- The collection of depreciation starting in 2026 once the project is complete and based on final costing; and
- The collection of AFUDC (subject to final financing obtained) until the project is complete.

The Board will consider this matter in a paper hearing process.

This is a public process, and you may participate as follows:

You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. This will allow
you to file evidence. Your request must be received by the Board by Friday, June 20, 2025,
and a copy of your evidence by Monday, August 25, 2025.
