## **DECISION AND ORDER**

Syri Auto Ltd. appealed to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on Friday, October 3, 2025, from a notice of administrative penalty dated Friday, September 12, 2025, issued by the Nova Scotia Apprenticeship Agency (Agency) under the *Apprenticeship and Trades Qualification Act*, SNS 2003, c 1, s 16G(3).

The Board notified the Agency of the appeal on Friday, October 10, 2025, and sought clarification on the date the Appellant was served with the notice. On Thursday, October 16, 2025, the Board received a letter from Rodney A. Woodworth, Manager, Compliance & Enforcement, indicating the Agency did not wish to pursue the administrative penalty. The letter further requested the Board to revoke the administrative penalty under s. 24B(4)(a) of the *Apprenticeship and Trades Qualifications Act*.

The Board reviewed the matter and determined there is no live issue to decide in this appeal.

In accordance with s. 24B(4)(a) of the Apprenticeship and Trades Qualifications Act, the Board orders the administrative penalty issued to Syri Auto Ltd. be revoked, effective immediately.
