TAKE NOTICE THAT TIDAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY of New Minas, Nova Scotia, made an application which was received by the Clerk of the Board on April 20, 2026, to amend Motor Carrier License P02825 to temporarily suspend its fixed route fees for Route 5E, Weymouth to Cornwallis and Route 5W, Cornwallis to Weymouth, on the dates noted below. All other route fares will be collected as normal.

Route 5E and 5W – July 3 - 6, 2026 – Lobster Bash Weekend

Route 5E and 5W – August 7 - 9, 2026 – Scallop Days Weekend

Route 5E and 5W – September 4 - 6, 2026 – Wharf Rat Rally Weekend

Route 5E and 5W – December 10 - 24, 2026 – Christmas Holidays

If no objections are received, the Board may grant the application without a public hearing.

If any objections are received, the public hearing of the applications will be set.
