TAKE NOTICE THAT PAUL MCNEIL O/A HALIFAX TITANIC HISTORICAL TOURS of Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, made applications which were received by the Clerk of the Board on July 23, 2026, requesting to amend Motor Carrier License No. P03167 and Extra Provincial Operating License No. XP03524 to extend all authorities under both licenses to the 14-passenger vehicle listed in Schedule E(2) to Motor Carrier License No. P03167 (Plate No. P01581). In particular, the Applicant seeks to amend Schedule F(2) of Motor Carrier License No. P03167 to include both vehicles under the license (E(1) and E(2)) and to add authority for a 14-passenger vehicle to operate under the same rates and authorities as in Extra Provincial Operating License No. XP03524.

TAKE NOTICE THAT PAUL MCNEIL O/A HALIFAX TITANIC HISTORICAL TOURS of Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, made an application received by the Clerk of the Board on July 23, 2026, requesting approval to partially lease Motor Carrier License No. P03167 and Extra Provincial Operating License No. XP03524 to the partnership of Paul McNeil and John Jeffrey Babineau. The lease would authorize the same rates and authorities associated with the vehicle identified in Schedule E(2) of Motor Carrier License P03167 (Plate No. P01581) under any applicable license held by the Applicant as of the date of the final lease agreement, if approved.

If no objections are received, the Board may grant the applications without a public hearing.

If any objections are received, a public hearing of the application will be set.
