HEARING ORDER

Nova Scotia Power Incorporated (NS Power) applied to the Nova Scotia Energy Board on July 31, 2026, for approval of a series of new and updated Tariffs following collaborative engagements between NS Power and Renewall Energy Incorporated. NS Power has proposed changes to the following Renewable to Retail Market Tariffs:

- Standby Service (SS) Tariff;
- Energy Balancing Service (EBS) Tariff; and
- Distribution Tariff

NS Power also proposes a new Distribution- connected Aggregation Service (DAS) Tariff to establish terms under which NS Power will provide distribution-connected generation aggregation services to a Licensed Retail Supplier.

In addition to the new and updated tariffs, NS Power proposed changes to the Licensed Retail Supplier Terms and Conditions to add reference to the new DAS Tariff and other administrative-related changes stemming from the proposed Tariff updates.

The Board has determined that this proceeding will be conducted by way of a paper hearing with written closing submissions, but the Board reserves the right to convert it to a full oral hearing if circumstances warrant. If leave is granted to intervenors or Board Counsel consultants to file evidence, or the matter is converted to an oral hearing, the schedule set out below will be revised.

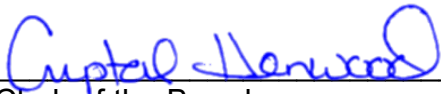
