## **DECISION AND ORDER**

4663423 Nova Scotia Limited o/a Atlantic Bus Corporation applied to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on August 8, 2025, for approval to amend Motor Carrier License No. P03525 by adding a Schedule F(3) Authority as follows:

## F(3) SPECIALTY SCHOOL BUS ANCILLARY SERVICE

All ancillary services reasonably necessary to support activities sanctioned by AVRCE schools. Such ancillary services may include but are not limited to: (i) transportation of students, teachers, educational assistants, chaperones, and other individuals for the support of school activities; (ii) transportation to and from school-sanctioned locations and events not otherwise captured in F(2) authority; and (iii) transportation on days other than scheduled school days.

And any other revisions that may be necessary to the license to give effect to the delivery of ancillary services.

Notice of application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, and notice provided to the industry. No objections were received by the Wednesday, September 10, 2025, deadline.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on September 11, 2025.

Having considered the *Motor Carrier Act*, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the application.

The Board approves the application, and orders that Motor Carrier License No. P03525 be amended accordingly, effective immediately.
