DECISION AND ORDER

Ayomikun Bus Charters Ltd. applied to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on October 20, 2025, for approval to amend its Motor Carrier License P03502 in accordance with Appendix A attached hereto.

Notice of the application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, November 5, 2025, and notice provided to the industry. There were no objections received by the stated deadline of November 12, 2025.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on November 24, 2025.
