**DECISION AND ORDER**

Tidal Transit Authority applied to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on April 20, 2026, for approval to amend Motor Carrier License P02825 to temporarily suspend its fixed route fees for Route 5E, Weymouth to Cornwallis, and Route 5W, Cornwallis to Weymouth, on the dates noted below. All other route fares will be collected as normal.

Route 5E and 5W – July 3 - 6, 2026 – Lobster Bash Weekend  
Route 5E and 5W – August 7 - 9, 2026 – Scallop Days Weekend  
Route 5E and 5W – September 4 - 6, 2026 – Wharf Rat Rally Weekend  
Route 5E and 5W – December 10 - 24, 2026 – Christmas Holidays


Notice of the Application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, April 22, 2026, and Notice provided to the industry. There were no objections received by the stated deadline of April 29, 2026.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on April 30, 2026.

Having considered the *Motor Carrier Act*, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the application.

**The Board approves the application and orders that the license be issued effective immediately.**
