DECISION AND ORDER

Melva Daley o/a Island Shuttle applied to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on January 30, 2026, for approval of the sale of Commercial Vehicle License No. CV01007 (CV License) to David J. Currie of Reserve Mines, Nova Scotia under 42B(7) of the *Board Public Passenger Motor Carrier Act Regulations*, which requires the approval of the Board.

On January 22, 2026, Island Shuttle registered a sole proprietorship change of owner with the Nova Scotia Registry of Joint Stock Companies.

Melva Daley entered into an agreement, effective March 1, 2026, for the sale of the sole proprietorship to David J. Currie including Commercial Vehicle License No. CV01007, and two (2) commercial vehicles with plates CV00200 and CV00344.

The Board has confirmed that David J. Currie is the Owner and has the use of the Business Name, 3065917 Island Shuttle, as registered with the Registry of Joint Stock Companies.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on February 9, 2026.

The Board approves the application, and orders that:

- 1. The sale of Commercial Vehicle License No. CV01007 is approved;**
- 2. The CV License is amended to reflect David J. Currie as Owner, with all existing operating authorities and schedules to the license remaining unchanged; and**
- 3. The Order is effective March 1, 2026.**
