


NOVA SCOTIA REGULATORY AND APPEALS BOARD

DECISION AND ORDER

The PEI Car Rental Company Inc. o/a PEI Coach Charters applied to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board on June 2, 2025, for the issue of a Temporary Authority to provide and operate two (2) 56-passenger highway motor coaches as follows:

SERVICES:

1. June 30, 2025, from Halifax Stanfield International Airport to Charlottetown and return on July 3, 2025; with an additional dropoff at the Canadian Museum of Immigration at Pier 21 on July 3, 2025; and stops in Pictou, Caribou Ferry Terminal, Wood Islands Ferry Terminal, and Truro, and
2. July 7, 2025, from Charlottetown to Halifax Stanfield International Airport and return on July 13, 2025; with stops in Borden-Carleton.

RATES:

\$5,500 per return trip plus HST.

Applications in relation to the issuance of Temporary Authority licenses are exempt from the public notice and public hearing requirements set out in s. 12 of the Motor Carrier Act.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on June 26, 2025.

The Board approves the application and orders that the Temporary Authority be issued, as noted above, effective immediately.
