The **NOVA SCOTIA UTILITY AND REVIEW BOARD** has started an investigation under the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations* requested by Steve R. Murphy's Auto Services Ltd. and WSK Investments Limited about whether the current wholesale margin for self-service and full-service gasoline and diesel is just and reasonable.
