



## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Interrupter for Price of Gasoline and Diesel Oil Invoked – Nova Scotia Energy Board**

**Monday, April 7, 2025** – Effective at midnight tonight, the price of all grades of gasoline and diesel oil will be adjusted. This change is necessary due to significant shifts in the market price of gasoline and diesel oil.

The benchmark price of gasoline and diesel oil is based on an average of the daily market price for refined product on the New York Mercantile Exchange (NYMEX), converted into Canadian dollars. The retail price paid at the pump is the benchmark price with wholesale margin, retailer markup, transportation allowance, winter blending (if required), cost of clean fuel regulations, an adjustment for retail margin, and taxes added.

The Nova Scotia Energy Board monitors the markets for gasoline and diesel oil daily and, should conditions warrant, may set a new price at any time.
